
Successful Neighbourhood Improvement Project (NIP) Bid

I'm writing to let you know that the NIP bid to improve the Crefeld Close play space was successful.

The bid was submitted by your Bayonne Estate Tenants & Residents Association (TRA) and the resident-led Investment Group decided to fully fund the project.

Who will be doing the works and what will be done

The improvements will be done by Idverde, our grounds maintenance contractor. Here's a snapshot of how the space will look:

- A** Signage to be secured at the entrance in to the play space. Exact wording and design to be confirmed
- B** Fencing and gates by others
- C** Softworks by others
- D** Bonded rubber mulch brown colour, laid over 50mm MOT type 1 with edges cut into existing surface - depths of rubber mulch to relate to the appropriate free fall heights
