There's a really active gardening group on the estate.

Some of their latest projects have included lavender planting along the edge of the multi-use games area (MUGA), the planting of 7 cherry trees as part of the Japan-UK Season of Culture 2019-2020, known as the Sakura project.

Flowering hawthorns have also been planted as part of a recent Neighbourhood Improvement Project (NIP) and three birch trees have been planted to commemorate 100 years since the end of the First World War.

There are regular planting and litter picking days on the estate, organised by the gardening club.
