Urban Ecology Trail Trail stop 5 - Queen Caroline Estate



Welcome to Queen Caroline estate, next to the iconic Hammersmith Bridge.

Queen Caroline estate is a large estate with over 300 properties. Over the years, there's been lots of exciting green projects that have taken place, including the Surface Urban Drainage Solutions (SuDs) that you're looking at today.

The estate also features green roofs, a herb garden, and tree planting.

The project was completed over five years ago as part of LIFE+ Climate proofing. The various SuDS components have been integrated within the housing estate landscape using a combination of roof space, pavement, car park, estate road and soft landscaped areas.

The estate's surface water drainage is connected to the combined sewer system.

DID YOU KNOW...

Queen Caroline was the wife of King George IV, and the couple had briefly lived in the nearby Brandenburgh House in Fulham. The names of the mid-rise residential blocks on the estate are named after queens of England: Margaret, Elizabeth, Eleanor, Isabella and Caroline.
