The idea for the project came from the Field Road Tenants & Residents Association who wanted a space that the community could come together and grow fruit and vegetables.

If you've got time, take a walk around the rest of the Field Road estate and see the fantastic work residents and Idverde, our grounds maintenance contractor, are doing to install planter boxes around the estate. Another project soon to begin is the removal of paving slab pathways next to Cox and Horton House to be replaced by eco-pathways made of grass and wildflower planting and reinforced with recycled plastic ground supports that make the pathways durable to walk on and can withstand the weight of vehicles too.

DID YOU KNOW ...

The Field Road estate is close to Charing Cross Hospital which was originally established in 1818. The estate is also close to Margravine Cemetery, one of the borough's 19 green flag parks
